### *Last month at the ASA . . . Philip Sedgwick*

Friday Lecture: Jupiter in Capricorn

Astrologers have been on edge about Pluto's entry into Capricorn, so Philip opened his talk by reassuring us. In 2020, Jupiter, Saturn and Pluto will all be together and squaring Eris. So it will take until then to get to the *real* gloom and doom. Meanwhile, everyone has the same question: "What am *I* going to do?"

Like Virgo and Scorpio, the sign Capricorn is more

misunderstood than others. Why? According to Alice Bailey, these signs come in three gradations, which adds complexity and gives them the ability to go many places other signs cannot. The first level, the crocodile, symbolizes human emergence from the primeval swamps. Our early ancestors struggled to leave the water and get a foothold on land. In this stage, we lose some of our unconscious mind, our feeling.

By the second stage, the human has been morphed. In the old symbolism, Capricorn was a sea-goat, a creature with a tail that allows it to swim and two feet on the earth. In a sense, this human has the best of both worlds, mundane-ness and sensitivity. We lost a lot when we switched to the mountain goat symbol.

As an aside, Philip noted that Chiron's wife, Chariklo, might have been one of these mermaid-like creatures. She was a sacred healer and Chiron's soul-mate.

The third stage is mastery, and its symbol is the unicorn. The horn, located at the third eye, is a beacon, a tuning fork. Alice Bailey saw this as the ability to have Christ consciousness while still on the planet. The unicorn climbs to the top of the sacred mountain.

The middle level is the goat level, which climbs to the top of the mundane mountain (the Dow vs. the Tao). It will only step on things that will support its weight, and indeed, Capricorn has an extreme perception of what will and will not support it.

The Latin word for goat, *caprus*, is also the root word of capricious. Capricorn's birthright is to be capricious. This thought led Philip to the new planetary bodies – what will they rule? In the 1970s, Philip thought Chiron ruled Virgo, but now he knows better.

Ceres IS a planet. As Gloria Star put it, a chihuahua may be small, but it's still a dog. We need to revert to a concept of classical astrology. If a planet can be seen, it can rule a sign. If it can't be seen, it can't

rule. But sometimes you can see Uranus and sometimes you can't. What then? In the sky, there's a 20° overlap between Capricorn and Aquarius. Let's give that to Uranus. Aquarians born in the 1920s and 1930s do not always display rebellious characteristics. They were far more Saturnian. Some of this was cultural. Aquarius has a Saturn clock, a set of standards and rules. They are methodical in their insanity.

In Capricorn, especially the last degrees, there's a resident weirdo wanting to come out. The most successful business-people, who personify Capricorn, are mavericks. They have a high standard of performance, and they can't work for anyone else.

In December, we had an alignment of Jupiter and Pluto to the Galactic Center. What happened? The inspiration came through, but it hasn't incarnated yet. Sagittarius has the idea. Capricorn gets off the sofa and does something about it.

This year, the issue is to take authority and ownership about things that were inspired last year. Sagittarius sees the big picture. The Capricorn quality is to get it done. But we need a new archetype to get things done. At this point, we can't even manage our own lives.

Right now, Scorpio, Sagittarius, Capricorn, and Aquarius hold more "stuff" (stars, black holes, pulsars) galactically than the rest of the sky. There will be a lot of energies impacting us. Furthermore, what's happening with Jupiter this year will continue to happen with Pluto in Capricorn until 2023.

Historically, Eris had a good relationship with Jupiter. In Mycenae, they conspired together to solve a political problem by reversing the normal process of events. In 1920, Eris was at 0° Aries. Now she's at 20° Aries. She takes 550 years to go around the Sun. Jupiter came into Capricorn in December, so people born in the 1920s were getting a Jupiter-Eris square around Christmas. Now, Jupiter is at 8° Capricorn, squaring the natal Eris of people born in the early 1950s. When Jupiter gets to

20°, everyone on earth will have had the square. We all need to reverse how we do our lives.

How are we going to make this change? Jupiter comes along and says it's time to educate you.

Philip passed out a list of deep space objects currently located in Capricorn and the dates Jupiter will pass over each object. For instance, on Christmas Day Jupiter went over the fastest spinning pulsar. Message: we couldn't get things done fast enough. Solution: don't think in terms of time; estimate how much energy everything will take. You'll be far more efficient. You'll even finish ahead of schedule if you allow yourself to use energetic tracking.

Pulsars are like light houses; they flash at given intervals. Their beacon-like quality is reminiscent of Mercury-Jupiter-Uranus. Is time accelerating? No, space is compressing. You can work through more area in less time because there's more density. Saturn is the least dense planet.

Pulsars are consistent in their emanations except when they're not. Some are long-period pulsars that go on and on. Others are just blips. Some are binary, having two sides. The message here is that you have to let both things be true. We should have learned this in Sagittarius. If both sides are allowed to be themselves, then they can talk.

Some pulsars are x-rays. This reveals a condition without interpretation – a nonjudgmental state of being. Philip said, "Judgment is generally applied when the reality of the situation is unlikeable." Then there are accreting pulsars, which pull the energy from others.

Reassign your energy to what you want it to be. Start paying attention to the energy shift from all the forces coming your way. Your attention accelerates the cellular shift going on within you. Once you shift the energy, don't look back. Don't revisit the old. Untangle the energy and shift the energy behind that. Stop trying to figure it out and just do it.

The Capricorn agenda is, “I know how I want to feel, and I know where I want to go, and I’m going there.” Feel your way through the experiences you’re trying to create. Allow for the energetic shift to become part of the vehicle you use – your body. This is Capricorn. Then you can maintain your vision of how things are supposed to look when you are through.

Pluto will make the issue of energy management vs. time management really clear. As Pluto tracks these deep space points, gradually people will become energy-savvy.

Black holes have the ability to warp time and space, so they can appear anywhere. A black hole punches a hole in the fabric of space and time. No light can escape from black holes but they are some of the brightest objects in space. They suck in everything around them and take their light, so they heat up the surrounding atmosphere. When you contact a black hole, you come back with a paradox. The irony of life.

Where are we now? Jupiter was directly aligned with black holes twice the week of the lecture. Black holes recreate the original energy of intent. You don’t want your spirit to waste away. If you don’t use it, it begins to collapse and go down the black hole. You need to use it.

The centaurs relied on a person’s scent to decide whether to approach or avoid that person. That’s the fundamental basis of physical attraction. The physicality is related to the energy inside.

This year, we’re coming to a basic level of energy management that everyone is learning. If everyone begins leaving the party when you arrive, it’s not what you’re wearing, it’s what you’re emanating.

Jupiter will be in orb of a black hole at 22° Capricorn three times –April, June, and November. This hole has superluminal jets. The fact that it’s bipolar in nature may indicate that we can gain a greater understanding of bipolarity. Creative people know

how to follow their energy – they have several projects going, and whichever one they work on next is the one that attracts them.

Create the energy alignment in your immediate environment. There’s always enough money for what you really want to do. Not having enough money is an excuse for not doing what other people want you to do. The energy of this hole is, “you can find a way.” Energy is intrinsically intelligent, and it knows what it’s attracted to and what repels it.

Align your energy with the situation. Right now, Pluto is conjunct the rapidly spinning pulsar. There’s no time for anything. Make it about energy, not time.

## **FEBRUARY'S ECLIPSES**

There is an annular eclipse of the Sun on February 6, 2008 at 17° of Aquarius at 8:44 PM MST. This positive eclipse brings in new beginnings and the desire to welcome new energy into our lives. It gives Leo, Aries and Sagittarius the courage to grab on to new opportunities. Also Aquarius, Gemini and Libra will get a lucky break this year.

This is a Saros Series Ten North eclipse. At the time of its origination at the North Pole on April 25, 1944, Uranus was at 28° of Gemini, Pluto was at 10° of Cancer, and Saturn was at 0° of Cancer. Mars has been crossing over these eclipse points from October 2007 though March 2008. According to Bernadette Brady in her book, Predictive Astrology, this eclipse has a strong emphasis on communication. The news, traffic, phone calls and other

means of conveying information may make us feel drained and scattered.

Mercury Retrograde in February touches this eclipse point on January 19, February 6, and March 4, 2008.

The path of this North Node solar eclipse is visible over most of Antarctica. Al Gore's message about global warming will hit home! According to Dietrech Pessin in her book, Lunar Shadows, North Node eclipses bring something new to our personal lives. For the next six months there is a focus on the self, working alone, and being involved with a fun and exciting project. If you started a new venture in fall of 2006, it may come to fruition in 2008.

Following are dates of planetary triggers to the Eclipse Point (EP) and some keywords. If you were born around the 6th or 7th of any month you may have events, revelations and experiences that open new vistas for you:

- \* February 6, 2008 - Mercury conjunct EP - Important e-mails and phone calls today.
- \* March 2, 2008 - Venus conjunct EP - A love affair may blossom.
- \* March 4, 2008 - Mercury conjunct EP - Close a business deal today.
- \* September 18 - October 2, 2008 - As the transiting north node hits 17° of Aquarius, relationships and projects initiated in winter of 2008 will bring karmic results.

There is a Total Lunar Eclipse on February 21, 2008 at 1° of Virgo at 8:30 PM MST. Lunar eclipses work at a subconscious level and bring out spiritual revelations as well as deep emotions. If you meet a new person at the time of a lunar eclipse, the relationship will most likely turn out to be intimate on some level and karmic in nature. In 2006, 2007 and 2008, there have been eclipses in earth signs – and that spells recession!
