Eileen Nauman, Doctor of Homeopathic Medicine (UK), has been a medical astrologer since 1970. Love, Money and Murder: The Chart of Laci Peterson

Judy presented Parts 1 and 2 of this material at the May and June meetings of ASA. The charts will be available on the website.

Ninety percent of the time, a person is murdered by someone they know. To investigate a murder astrologically, you must start with the first absolutely verified time you can find. The time of the 911 call is often the best place to begin. Work with charts you know and form an opinion. Look for the planets or points that are aspected in the charts of both people involved.

Often, the chart of a murder victim won't look bad. Many victims have grand trines and other positive aspects. Perhaps these people are too trusting. The chart of the murderer generally looks worse.

Natal charts

Laci Peterson's birth data is March 4, 1975 at 4:45 am, Modesto, California. This time is not confirmed. What could contribute to her being kidnapped? If her time is correct, the Placidus house system gives her 18 degrees of Scorpio — “the accursed degree in the accursed sign” — on the 8th cusp. Her Mercury is in 29 degrees of Taurus, conjunct the “weeping sisters” fixed star, giving Laci something to weep about. It was also quincunx Uranus, showing a tendency to make very poor decisions. Her south node is conjunct that Mercury, so she was fatally attracted to a man who had money and good looks.

Laci had a grand trine involving the Moon,

Venus, and Uranus. Since Uranus fell into her 7th, she wanted a marriage partner who would be exciting and unconventional. Her husband, Scott, was handsome and drove a purple Mercedes. However, his desire for freedom turned out to be her downfall. Laci's Uranus was in 29 degrees of Libra and retrograde, so the marriage was karmic. She also had a retrograde Neptune in the 8th house, giving her reason to be worried about her partner's finances.

Her natal Mercury and Uranus were quincunx. This shows that her partner could leave at a moment's notice. In her progressed chart, solar arc Mars squares Saturn. Saturn rules her 10th—the end of her marriage (4th from the 7th).

By solar arc progression, there's a trine involving Saturn, Jupiter, and Neptune. The eclipse of Dec. 12 hit Neptune, activating all those planets. On Dec. 19 a full moon at 27° Gemini occurred right between her progressed Mercury and south node, setting off the natal Mercury-Uranus quincunx. This meant a fight was coming.

Solar arc Uranus squares her natal Moon, which rules her 4th house (her burial site). Natally, Saturn is in her 4th, showing a delayed burial.

Scott Peterson's birth time is not known, so Judy used the noon chart. His known data is October 24, 1972 in San Diego, California. He has a yod, and Neptune fills in the sensitive point between the two sextiles. His Saturn is at the degree of the nodes, in Gemini, giving him an inability to communicate or to think through long-term consequences. His Sun, Mercury and Venus are virtually unaspected.

In Scott's solar arc progressed chart, nearly every natal point was hit negatively by a solar arc planet. The June 10, 2002 eclipse hit Saturn and that's the day he took out an insurance policy on Laci—but not one on himself. Whenever an event happens on an eclipse, it's fated. It's pretty hard to get out of it.

The third partner of the love triangle, Amber Frey, was born on Feb. 10, 1975 in San Diego. Her time is not known, so Judy used noon. Most of her personal planets are unaspected, indicating that she is shallow and amoral. Her main role was

to be a karmic trigger. Her main configuration is a nasty t-square in which Mars opposes Saturn, and Pluto squares them both.

Amber's natal Uranus is conjunct Scott's Sun. The night they met, transiting Venus hit that Uranus-Sun combination.

Event charts

Whenever you study a homicide, it is helpful to look at the last contact the victim had with anyone prior to being murdered. Laci talked to her mother on the phone at 8:30 pm. What in that chart would lead you to believe something might happen? Look at applying aspects only. The Moon opposes Uranus by 16 minutes and a Venus-Mars conjunction in Scorpio squares Jupiter by 48 minutes. Seven minutes after Laci hung up the phone, Pluto went into her 4th house.

The next chart is for the time of Scott's 911 call. What is rising? 16 degrees of Cancer. According to Ivy Jacobson, an event is ruled by the Sun and the activity is ruled by the Moon. Let's look at the aspects the Moon makes. The Moon is quincunx the 8th cusp: he's lying. The Moon is also at the degree of the nodes: she's already dead. Mercury rules the 4th (the end of the matter) and is in 22 degrees of Capricorn. Mercury is quincunx Saturn, showing that Laci's "disappearance" will be resolved by news of her death. Saturn is in the 12th: her body has been hidden and the person responsible (7th house) will go to prison.

Scott was arrested on April 19 at 11:10 am in Modesto. Again, 16 degrees of Cancer was rising. The Saturn and Pluto opposition is still in effect, and both are squared by Venus. The Sun exactly opposes his 7th-degree Uranus, and the degree on the 4th house of the arrest chart is 28 Virgo, the same degree as Laci's ill-fated Mercury. Keep an eye on late mutable degrees when the trial comes up.

Other relevant charts

Laci's body was found on April 14, 2003 at 12:15 pm in San Francisco. There are many hits from her chart to that chart. There is a confirmed

sighting of Scott with a boat on December 24 at 9:30 am. The Moon was in 3 degrees of Virgo. Three degrees is important in both his and Amber's charts. Between 11:40 and 11:42 am on December 24, Venus and Pluto were parallel in the heavens. Could this be the exact time he disposed of the body? All we know for sure is that it happened between 9 am and 12 noon.

Friday Lecture — Saturn in Cancer

The current period will last from June 4, 2003 to July 15 2005.

The most recent Saturn in Cancer period lasted from August 2, 1973 to January 7, 1974 and April 19, 1974 - September 16, 1975 and from January 15, 1976 to June 4, 1976

The Vietnam War ended in 1975.

250,000 war deaths

Cost: \$109.5 billion

In 1976, North and South Vietnam reunited

Previous to that, Saturn was in Cancer from June 20, 1944 to August 2, 1946

VE Day = May 8, 1945

End WWII = August 14, 1945

35 million war deaths

Comparing the three periods, it is important to note that the second period had two retrogrades, which differentiated it from the other two. However, in both of the previous two periods, there were two negotiated peace treaties. The two in the second period did not hold and the United States withdrew from Vietnam in 1975.

Why would Saturn in Cancer be synonymous with peace? Saturn = limitation, discipline, responsibility; Moon = emotion, women, etc.

With limitation in emotion, it is possible to

negotiate. So in this period, there is the possibility of peace negotiations at least.

In the previous period, Gerald Ford, Cancer Sun sign, took office as Vice President soon after Saturn entered Cancer. During the period that he was President and with Saturn in Cancer, there were two assassination attempts. In the present period, we have a Cancer Sun-sign President as well.

Saturn in Cancer is also separation from the father and with some soldiers not returning from war, this is a sad fact in all three periods.

As Saturn in Cancer relates to crime and punishment (responsibility), the previous period brought us the Watergate saga with its "players," Erlichman, Haldeman and Mitchell, being sentenced from 2-8 years; Dean, Magruder, Colson and McCord being released; and Hunt and Liddy serving the most time, with Martha Mitchell much in the limelight.

In the current period of corporate fraud, we already have the Imclone executive being sentenced to 8 years, and Martha Stewart facing possible incarceration. The drive to hold executives responsible may expand to include some of the bigger players such as Enron and Worldcom executives. In both periods, the misdeeds were less of an issue than the cover-ups.

In the previous period, we had droughts, floods and earthquakes. We have already had a string of earthquakes beginning in California/Alaska, moving to Alabama, and then across the Atlantic to Turkey and Algeria. This can be attributed to the separation of Saturn from Pluto—the opposition this time, and the square last time.

The Concorde just completed a whole Saturn cycle from first flight to last.

Transits of Saturn in Cancer

During the last period Howard Hughes and Aristotle Onassis, both Capricorn Sun signs, died. Transiting Saturn in Cancer is not beneficial for Capricorn planets. Ditto for Aries and Libra. For the men with Sun in those signs, it means responsibilities and possible health problems,

ranging from a toothache to a heart attack. For women, it can mean separation from the men in their lives through death or geography.

For Moon in any of those signs it means guilt and tears, with possible health problems for the women.

Mercury = depression; Venus = not good for love or money; Mars = frustration and pain. Watch Amber Frey next year. To Jupiter it means containment.

Saturn in Cancer opposite Saturn in Capricorn: the challenge of being 14 (parental restriction); 43 (parental responsibility); 73 (personal limitations, such as being homebound).

Saturn in Cancer opposite Uranus in Capricorn: This limits the political freedoms of these individuals, who are now in their teens.

Saturn in Cancer to Neptune in Capricorn: for individuals aged 6-19, this is a chemical imbalance causing fear and anxiety.

Positive transits

Saturn in Cancer is good news for Scorpio, Pisces, Taurus and Virgo planets.

Career improvements for the Scorpios — watch Hillary Clinton. Right now she has Mars, Saturn and Uranus all trining her Sun, but she may be peaking too soon! Ditto Scott Peterson.

Pisces will have work and health improvements and responsibility through children with romantic stability.

Taurus will enjoy home improvement; Virgo will have better insights and stability in friendships.

For the Moon in any of those signs, Saturn in Cancer means emotional stability.

Mercury = common sense; Venus = better for money than love; to Mars, it is the ability to do sustained work and complete projects. Jupiter = slow, steady gain.

Saturn in Cancer trine Saturn in Scorpio and Pisces occurs at age 21 and 68. Reward for past effort. Obviously at 68, you've put in more effort, but the ex-POW, Jessica Lynch, has Saturn at 0 degrees of Scorpio and she will benefit from her tribulation. The secrecy surrounding her is interesting to note.

Saturn in Cancer sextile Saturn in Taurus and Virgo will be financially beneficial and improve health or work situations, respectively.

Saturn in Cancer trine Uranus in Scorpio will help those who are having their Saturn Return. They may want to get rid of some of those tattoos and piercings, or those who are only 23 may feel comfortable in their individuality. Again, Amber Frey will have this trine around the time of her first Saturn Return, and already her father has stated his support for her.

Currently, the exact trine from Saturn to Uranus in Pisces occurs on June 24, BUT Uranus is retrograde. Still, June and July should be months of relative peace.

Saturn in Cancer trine Neptune in Scorpio will be welcomed by those 34-47 years of age. They've had a rough time going through their Pluto square Pluto and Neptune square Neptune, so those who are getting the sextile from Saturn now will find it helping them face reality and able to cope with it. Those closer to 34 will still have to face the aforementioned challenges in the future. The tax cut will benefit this age group the most.

Saturn in Cancer to Pluto in Scorpio will open doors for those aged 9 to 20 years old over the next 2+ years.

Saturn conjunctions

Saturn to Pluto in Cancer = one door closes and another door opens. This is true for all Saturn to Pluto transits. However, for Pluto in Cancer it can literally mean doors, as in moving.

Saturn to Neptune in Cancer = very nostalgic or forgetful (age 90+)

Saturn to Uranus = limit of freedoms. If the hippies did now what they did "then," they could be arrested as terrorists. The Patriot Act enforced.

Saturn to Saturn – the first and second Saturn Returns – maturity and taking responsibility for oneself as opposed to leaning on the parents. Getting approval from the parents is more difficult than getting their support. If this is still the case during the second Saturn Return, this will be a difficult transit.

Saturn to Jupiter through Venus is similar to the squares and oppositions.

Saturn to Mercury can be practical thinking, but it can also mean pessimism or depression.

Saturn to the Moon can mean stability and responsibility, but it is still a downer. Guilt and shoulds!

Saturn in Cancer conjunct the Sun: men need to guard their health. Responsibility! The women can stabilize their relationships. Divorce or some kind of separation is possible.

The U.S. and President Bush

Marta discussed the US Chart, using Gemini Rising and the equal house system. The solar eclipse of May 30 at 9 degrees of Gemini seems to have brought a new approach. The President visited overseas, attended the G8 conference, etc.

Pisces on the 10th house very much describes our leaders.

The first 5 degrees = circa 6 weeks and it's gone! Ditto 14-19, 28 and 29 degrees.

Watch degrees 10-13, especially in October and November, and 6-9 degrees from January through May, 2004.
